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MINUTES OF THE FOURTH MEETING OF THE PROJECT APPROVAL BOARD (PAB) OF THE NATIONAL MISSION ON EDUCATION THROUGH INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT) HELD ON 20TH APRIL, 2009 AT 3.30 P.M IN CONFERENCE ROOM NO. 112-C WING, SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION

The fourth meeting of the Project Approval Board (PAB) of National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT) was held at 3.30 P.M on 20th April, 2009 in the Conference Room No. 112-C Wing Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, Department of Higher Education. The list of participants is at Annexure-I. Shri R.P. Agarwal, Secretary, Higher Education welcomed all the members and appreciated the good work being done by the members of the Committees formed by the PAB under the centrally sponsored scheme of National Mission on Education "through Information and Communication Technology and," thereafter, "agenda items" were discussed and the following decisions were taken:

Item No. 1 To confirm the minutes of the 3rd meeting of the Project Approval Board held on 25th March, 2009 and to note the action taken thereon

Discussions were held on the minutes of the third meeting of Project Approval Board held on 25/03/2009. It was noted by the representative of Department of Telecom (DoT) that the Due Diligence for implementation of connectivity to more than 18,000 colleges and 450 Universities could be done only with the help of Ministry of HRD as DoT does not have the machinery in place. Also, individual operators and service providers in local regions throughout the country needed to be sensitized to the varying needs of local institutions. In response to this observation, the Secretary noted that a Due Diligence Committee would be set up for this purpose and proposed that DoT's representative be part of the same committee, for which, Table Agenda was being placed before the Board. Thereafter, the minutes of the third meeting were approved by the members.

Item No. 2 Ratification of the six proposals approved by Chairman, PAB pursuant to authorization by PAB in its meeting held on 25th March, 2009

In view of the short time before the end of the last financial year, the PAB had formally authorized the Chairman to approve Standing Committee's recommendations on the selection of projects on 28th March, 2009. The Chairman expressed his satisfaction with the Standing Committee's work and requested the PAB for ratification. He also requested the standing committee to provide the list of experts who were contacted for the review of the six pilot project proposals. He desired that henceforth, the minutes/recommendations of the Standing Committee should also indicate the names of those domain experts who were

consulted by the Standing Committee in respect of each of the Project proposals considered by it. The PAB ratified the sanction of six projects.

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Item No. 3 To consider and approve the recommendations of the Standing — Committee meeting to be held on 20th April, 2009 at 10.30 a.m.

The following four projects which had been submitted to the Mission were recommended by the Standing committee which met in the morning of 20th April, 2009 in Room No. 112-C Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. Due to the very short time between the two meetings, the detailed minutes of the Standing Committee meetings would also be circulated to all the PAB members by e-mail. Upon receipt of the same, the Chairman agreed to consider sanctioning the recommendations of the Standing Committee:-

Other Items:

Thereafter, general issues of importance were discussed.

1. It was suggested by the PAB members that the current proposal review mechanism followed by the Standing Committee be strengthened by including other external domain experts wherever necessary. It was decided to include the names of the following experts in the standing Committee:

(i) Prof. Sadanand More, Pune University

(ii) Prof. Jaishree Shinde, SNDT

The Chairman also desired that the Standing Committee should examine all the proposals submitted so far before taking up further proposals for consideration. It was also suggested by a member that the projects be so chosen in future so as to represent a wide participation from all parts of the country and also as many disciplines as possible.

2. It was also felt that the proposal may be taken up for consideration on the first come first serve basis for transparency.

3. It was also decided that the projects which are to be sanctioned after due recommendation of the PAB may be put on the website and actual release of grant to these projects should be released only after waiting for sometime so that views expressed by the public were taken into account before the final release of grant. It was also decided that IITs namely IIT-Delhi, IIT-Kanpur, IIT-Kharagpur, IIT-Chennai, IIT-Mumbai, IIT-Guwahati, IIT-Roorkee and IISc-Bangalore may hold workshops of the institutions, colleges, Universities in their catchment area with a view to disseminate the objectives and needs of the Mission and seek projects from the participating stakeholders. Decision was also taken to provide Rs. 2 lakhs to each of these institutions for holding these workshops.

4. An issue was raised by Prof. Surender Kumar, Director, IIT, Delhi with regard to further disbursement of the money received by the Principal Coordinators of the institutions from the Ministry under National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology. Director, IIT, Delhi wanted an authorization in this regard from the Ministry. Mission Director informed that all these issues might be decided through consensus amongst the partners and if consensus was not found possible, the decision may be taken by the Leader of the project. In case of difficulty, the issues may be raised with PAB for final decision.

5. It was also decided that the final utilization certificate in respect of the grant released by the Ministry shall be furnished by the Principal Coordinator i.e. Project Leader to the Ministry.

6. It was also decided that the purchase procedure as was being followed in IITs might be followed in the projects being approved under the National Mission.

7. The representative of the Planning Commission mentioned that as far as possible, each project should highlight its importance. To this, Chairman, PAB agreed and further desired that the Standing Committee may apprise the Project Coordinators/proposes that they should mention in each project about the following:-

- (i) Time frame of completion of the project
- (ii) Outcome of the project

(iii) Overall benefit which will accrue to the Mission

8. The Standing Committee was also asked to prioritize the areas and the extent of grants to be released for every area during the current financial year keeping in view the total budgetary allocation of Rs. 552 crores for the current financial year.

9. It was decided that all institutions be told as to what they would get under the National Mission.

10. After completion of consideration of 151 projects received so far, the Standing Committee should identify activities where sufficient number of project proposals have either not been received or not been sanctioned and then make efforts to encourage experts in those areas to submit worthwhile proposals so that all the Mission- activities get covered holistically.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
