MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made and entered on this 29th day of April 2020 at New Delhi

BY AND BETWEEN

The Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, herein after referred as MHRD, as the First Party.

AND

CSC e-Governance Services India Limited, a company Incorporated Under Companies Act 1956 having its registered office at Electronics Niketan, 4th Floor, DIT, Programme Management Unit, 6 CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi 110 003, which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, shall deem to mean and include its successors and assigns, hereinafter referred to as CSC SPV, as the Second Party.

WHEREAS

- A. MHRD through its National Online Education Platform "SWAYAM" offers Free Online Education to students across the country in multiple disciplines such as Engineering, Law, Management, Humanities & Social Sciences and Professional Courses, designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy - Access, Equity and Quality.
- B. MHRD would like to improve the access to the Online Education Platform "SWAYAM" especially from the remote parts of the country.
- C. CSC SPV has a large number of Community Service Centres (CSC) numbering 3,50,000 spread across length and breadth of the country which could be used by the students for accessing SWAYAM.
- D. For the afore mentioned reasons, MHRD and CSC SPV have decided to sign an MoU with roles and responsibilities as detailed here under:

1.0 Roles and Responsibilities of MHRD:

- 1.1 MHRD would support the access / integration of SWAYAM with CSC Digital Sewa Portal.
- 1.2 MHRD through the Course Coordinators would run the courses in SWAYAM and organise the final proctored examination through National Testing Agency (NTA).
- 1.3 MHRD would nominate a single point of contact for interface with CSC SPV.

2.0 Roles and Responsibilities of CSC SPV:

- 2.1 CSC SPV would ensure that the SWAYAM Platform is accessible / integrated with their Digital Sewa Portal and is accessible from all Community Service Centres across the country.
- 2.2 CSC SPV would create awareness on SWAYAM Courses in general and those currently being offered in particular.
- 2.3 The students should be able to enrol for the SWAYAM Courses and undergo the same through the Community Service Centres.
- 2.4 The CSCs can charge the standard approved charges as decided by CSCSPVfor usage of resources at the Community Service Centres. No Special / Additional Charges would be levied for accessing SWAYAM.
- 2.5 A Monthly Report would be provided to MHRD regarding the SWAYAM related activities at the Community Service Centres.
- 2.6 A single point of contact for interface with MHRD would be nominated.
- 2.7 CSC SPV shall display a Board / footer on its Webpage stating that SWAYAM Courses are also available outside CSC on any internet ready device.
- 2.8 CSC SPV would also provide periodic reports on enrolment, progress, those taking exams and passing.

2.9 CSC SPV will encourage Group Learning.

3.0. Commencement and termination of MoU

- The MoUshall come in force from the date it is signed by the parties.
- 3.2 The MoU shall be in force for a period of Five Years, renewable for a period mutually decided by both the Parties. However, it can be terminated by either party by giving 30 Days' notice in writing.

4.0. AMENDMENT OF THE MoU

The intended obligations of Parties have been outlined in the MoU. However, during the term of this MoU, circumstances may arise which may call for alteration/modifications of this MoU. Modifications/ alterations shall be first mutually discussed by the Parties and agreed in writing to become the supplement MoUs.

5.0 DISPUTE & REDRESSAL MECHANISM

- i. In case of any dispute between the parties, the dispute shall be amicably resolved in a meeting of the heads of the organizations. However if such an effort fail, and in the event any dispute, difference, question, etc. in respect of this MoU arises between the parties hereto or their respective representatives or assignees at any time, inconnection with construction, meaning, operation, effect, interpretation or arising out of the MOU or breach thereof, effort (s) shall be made initially to settle the dispute amicably through mutual discussion within a period of three months.
- In case it is not possible to resolve the dispute amicably by mutual consultation amongst the parties, the same may be referred to Secretary, Higher Education, MHRD, Government of India.
